

# How to record on your phone.

When the printable book isn't enough — let them just talk.

If your storyteller would rather talk than write, hand them the phone instead.

### Tap the link

Open the text message or email you received. Tap the link that starts with [app.lineageletters.com](http://app.lineageletters.com) or [api.lineageletters.com/teller/...](http://api.lineageletters.com/teller/)

### Allow microphone

The browser will ask for permission. Tap Allow. You only have to do this once.

3

### Read the question

It will be displayed in large type. You can read it out loud if it helps you start.

4

### Tap the big red button

It's near the bottom of the screen. The button will start pulsing — that means it's recording.

5

### Talk

There is no time limit (up to 20 minutes per answer). Pause, breathe, think. Long silences are fine.

6

### Tap the red button again to stop

The page says Saved. The next time you open the link, the next question is waiting.

### Tips for the best recording

- Find a quiet room. Turn off the TV, close the window if there's traffic.
- Hold the phone normally, in your hand — not pressed to your ear.
- Sit comfortably. You may be talking for a while.
- Pour yourself a glass of water or a cup of tea before you start.
- If you don't remember something, just say so. A short answer is still a real answer.
